A just like in every other townhome, including kitchen, dining, living, bedroom, bathrooms, laundry, etc.







Aspirations

- Pedestrian connectivity between Elliot and Severne be preserved
- Community space and pedestrian connectivity along Elliot street
- Walkable from site to all shops and services.
- No connectivity to Lang Street that would remain closed.
- Building format to be townhouses and 4-plex units.
- Units would be primarily owned, with a modest number of affordable rentals.
- Cohousing will support the broader community by acting as a connection point.
- Build the 28 units allowed by present zoning, cluster them and create a community garden and greenspaces within the development
