



Salish Sea Stones Mission Statement

Our mission for Salish Sea Stones is to help vulnerable and sick children through the medium of a unique stone art process. We produce these individualised and personalised stone art pieces for children/youth in Hospital Paediatric Units and Transition Houses. These kids will often use their stone as a comfort to help aid in their recovery. We also produce stone art to sell in local outlets with all money made going to help local kids in need.

Schools are taking the project on and their students are learning this unique art skill in order to create their own stones, often using their own art on these stones. Then the schools sell these stones in local selected outlets, with all money made going to help local kids in need.

Renowned local artists are also helping the project by donating some art to go on our stones for sale and collaborating with the school groups on the art they create for their stones. This allows the school groups to produce fantastic art for their stones and have that art displayed and sold locally to help other kids in need. That is a hugely empowering process for these students.

Salish Sea Stones project is bringing the local community together to help vulnerable groups by:

Children/Youth in Hospitals and Transition Houses are helped to heal by receiving their very own Salish Sea Stone.

School students are learning a new stone art process, then having their own art displayed on their stones and ultimately have that stone sold locally to help local kids in need. They are also communicating and collaborating with other schools locally, provincially and internationally who have taken the project on.

Local businesses help with material costs and multiple outlets are selling the Salish Sea Stones to raise money for local kids/youth in need.
