4.1 Ravens Nest Child and Youth

Lia Versaeval from Ravens Nest Child and Youth Advocacy Centre provided a

presentation to Council on a project that was developed in 2022 in North Cowichan that provides advocacy and support for children who have been victims of a crime and answered questions from Council. Ms. Versaeval ended the presentation by extending an invitation to Council to tour their facility in the future.

6. STAFF REPORTS

6.1 2023-2027 Utility Rate Review

The Chief Financial Officer, Talitha Soldera provided a presentation and answered questions from Council.

Council, by unanimous consent, recessed the meeting at 5:35 p.m. and reconvened at 5:37 p.m.

IT WAS MOVED AND SECONDED:

THAT the Committee of the Whole direct staff to prepare the Financial Plan Bylaw, a Fees and Charges Amendment Bylaw and a Sewer and Water Parcel Tax Amendment Bylaw to:

- (1) Increase Chemainus water metered minimum and parcel tax by 5% per year for five years;
- (2) Increase Crofton water metered minimum and parcel tax by 5% per year for five years;
- (3) Increase South End water metered minimum and parcel tax by 3% per year for five years; and
- (4) Increase metered water rates (for amounts over the minimum) for all water utilities by 3% per year for five years.

IT WAS MOVED AND SECONDED:

THAT the Committee of the Whole direct staff to prepare the Financial Plan Bylaw, a Fees and Charges Amendment Bylaw and a Sewer and Water Parcel Tax Amendment Bylaw to:

- (1) Increase Chemainus sewer parcel tax and user fees by 2% per year for four years beginning in 2024;
- (2) Increase Crofton sewer parcel tax and user fees by 3% per year for five years;
- (3) Increase South End sewer parcel tax and user fees by 5% per year for five years; and,
- (4) Increase Maple Bay sewer treatment plant parcel tax and user fee by 3% per year for five years. CARRIED

6.3 2023 Grants in Aid
