I would like to thank you for your consideration of this grant request.

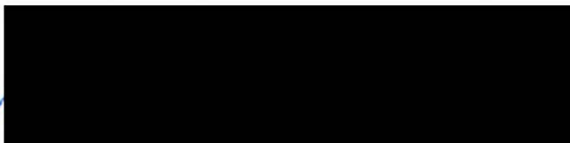
A representative of our Crofton Art Group has advised us that they are looking for funding to put up their original artworks on the lamp standards in town to celebrate their 70th anniversary next year.
