Highway Use Amendment Bylaw

BYLAW NO. 3936

A bylaw to amend Highway Use Bylaw No. 2261 to regulate the public use of municipal sidewalks.

The Council of The Corporation of The District of North Cowichan, enacts in open meeting assembled, as follows:

Citation

1 This Bylaw may be cited as "Highway Use Amendment Bylaw No. 3936, 2024".

Amendment

- 2 Highway Use Bylaw No. 2261, 1988, is amended by:
 - (a) Adding section 9.1 as follows:
 - "9.1 No person shall engage in any sport, amusement, exercise or occupation on a sidewalk or walkway or stand, walk, run or loiter in such a manner as to unreasonably obstruct, impede or interfere with the free passage of another person on a sidewalk or walkway."
 - (b) Adding the following as subsection (1.1) under section 10 [Merchandise on highways]:
 - "(1.1) No person shall place or cause to be placed any materials, objects, structures, chattel, obstruction, vehicle or other thing that is, or is likely to be, a nuisance, or hinders, interferes, or obstructs the free use of a highway, sidewalk or boulevard."
