Traffic Bylaw Amendment Bylaw

BYLAW NO. 3971

A bylaw to amend the Traffic Bylaw to allow the Director, Engineering, to place, erect and remove traffic control devices without Council's approval.

The Council of The Corporation of The District of North Cowichan, enacts in open meeting assembled, as follows:

Citation

1 This Bylaw may be cited as "*Traffic Bylaw Amendment Bylaw No. 3971, 2024*".

Amendment

2 Traffic Bylaw No. 2276, 1988 is amended by:

- (a) renaming "Director of Engineering and Operations" in section 3 to "Director, Engineering".
- (b) renaming "Manager of Operations" in section 3 to "Director, Operations" and repositioning it in the definitions list alphabetically.
- (c) striking out "Director of Engineering and Operations" in sections 4(1), 4(4), 4(5), 18(1), and 19, and inserting "Director, Engineering" in its place.
- (d) striking out "Manager of Operations" in section 18(1), and inserting "Director, Operations" in its place.
- (e) deleting subsection 4(1)(f) in its entirety and inserting the following in its place:

"(f) on a highway where construction, reconstruction, widening, repair, marking, or other work is being carried out, providing an indication that people or equipment are working;"
- (f) deleting subsection 4(3) in its entirety and inserting the following in its place:

"Traffic control devices may, from time to time, as required on a highway where construction, reconstruction, widening, repair, marking, or other work if being carried out, be placed by a traffic control officer of by the Director, Engineering, to regulate or prohibit traffic in the vicinity of the work."

(g) deleting subsection 4(6) in its entirety.
