We ended our conversation with you saying that you would think about my common sense approach that would provide a permanent solution to my family bench. I appreciate the offer that you made to me by grandfathering me for 20 years instead of 10 years. I will have to seriously consider that offer if you don't see it my way.

Mr. Mason quoted me 1000.00 to refurbish the bench this fall with inflation being what it is in 2035 when the bench is up for refurbishing again the cost will probably be higher.

I have been told by the company that makes these benches (Wishbone) that the maintenance is minimal for many decades to follow.

I think this is the best way to go long term for the community and tax payers of North Cowichan.
